Expectations:

- Attend scheduled meetings – Schedule TBA
- Promote and support RMHC special events and fundraisers
- Plan (as a group) 2-3 Teen Board fundraising events throughout the year
- Complete 6 service hours per month (*which may include but is not limited to*):
Attending meetings or other scheduled activities (i.e. Clean up day)
Planning/implementation of TB sponsored special event
Volunteer Shift at RMH or Family Room
- Volunteer at McHappy Day (November 20th), Pop Tab Pandemonium (April) and Ride for Ronald (May)
- Serve as an Ambassador for RMHC in your school, home and community
- Membership dues of \$40.00. These dues/donations establish the operating budget for the Teen Board and will also provide a T-shirt. Donations are non-refundable. Financial Aid Scholarships are available based on need.

Selection Process:

Deadline for application is May 21st, 2010 at 5:00 p.m. – no exceptions will be made. Returning members must submit application but will not be required to interview. First-time candidate application materials will be screened to meet the minimal requirement of 10th grade level and those selected for an interview will be contacted no later than June 7th to schedule an interview. Those selected to serve on the 2010-11 Teen Board will be notified no later than July 16th.

Candidates are selected following their interviews to serve on the Teen Board based on the following:

- Thoroughness and sincerity of answers
- Sense of responsibility
- Ability to communicate ideas
- Sincerity towards volunteer commitment to RMHC
